"Truly I tell you, everyone who sins is a slave to sin. Now a slave has no permanent place in the family, but a son belongs to it forever. So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed" (John 8:34-36).

Do you ever feel like a mouse on a treadmill?

Life is spinning by at a dizzying pace, yet you seem to be going nowhere. Despite your greatest efforts, you seem to be stuck without a purpose. Could there be some key ingredient missing from your life?

The Israelites in Egypt felt like that. All they did was make bricks all day and we know exactly how they did it. Not only does the Bible tell us, but archaeologists have found pictures of the Egyptian brick-making process painted on the walls of tombs.

First, the Israelites would get dirt, then they would mix it with water to make mud, and then they would mix the mud with straw. Finally, they would put the wet brick into a mold and wait for it to dry. It was repetitive, meaningless, and back-breaking work under the hot Egyptian sun.

> To make matters worse, Pharaoh, the Egyptian king, ordered that the Israelites not be given any straw for their bricks. That meant they had to find their own and, although they had to do this extra work, they still had to make the same amount of bricks (Exodus 5:6-8).

A Life Without Purpose?

You were freed for a purpose

It can't have made any sense to the Israelites. They were just on a treadmill to nowhere. Many of them must have thought that's just the way life was; after all, they had been slaves for generations. Life was bleak; without hope, without purpose.


> Life can often seem without purpose. It feels as though we are being asked to make bricks without straw. Everything seems harder than it should be, and ultimately pointless.

> > Like the Israelites, we can fall into the trap of thinking that today is all there is. But the bricks without straw was a clue that the Israelites were missing something in life; something that was their birthright, that only God could provide.

And he died for all, that those who live should no longer live for themselves but for him who died for them and was raised again (2 Corinthians 5:15).

Christ's sacrifice provides the motivation that we need. It is the gift that lifts us up. This is the only way we can get out of ourselves. It is of no use to try and whip ourselves up to religious emotions in order to discharge certain duties.

Only when faith is used as an eye to focus on Christ nailed to that terrible tree can we become united with the very power of the heavenly throne itself. If we want ice to melt, we put it out in the sunshine. If we want a mirror to gleam, we do not spend all our time in polishing it, but rather we carry it where it can catch the sun's rays and flash them back in glory. The Bible says, "We love him because he first loved us" (1 John 4:19). All that we do that is good is just an echo of God's good.

To contemplate Calvary and to recognise our part in it is to find in God a new centre. To understand the meaning of that event is to find self-displaced. We can no longer live to ourselves, says the apostle (Romans 14:7; 2 Corinthians 5:15). To know that we

are loved, despite what we are, leads us to love others despite what they are. To see the evidence of God's patience towards us inspires us to be patient with the rest of our kind. To catch a glimpse of the hope of Paradise to a remorseful thief arouses in us an undying hope. To behold Christ's willing subjection to his crucifixion energises us in a way that nothing else can.

Call on him until he reveals that we too died on that cross. We are now Christ's. The only life we have now is the one he has given us. We confess that we are not our own, for we were bought with a price. Now it is true as we behold heaven's wondrous grace that "sin shall not have dominion over you: for you are not under the law, but under grace" (Romans 6:14).

We shall therefore live no longer for ourselves but for him who for our sake died and was raised again. There is no other way to right living, to the health of our body and soul.


FROM OUR SURVEY

NEVER TOO OLD FOR A NEW LEASE ON LIFE

God has used GNU's ministry to help these elderly people find new hope and purpose in the love of Jesus.

Pastor Joseph takes up the story: "At the end of their lives, they are really living!

"We hold Gospel meetings every month at the Good News Divine Centre in India. The elderly people come from seven surrounding villages – Venanapudi, Pedda Veerivada, Nandiwada, Koduru, Bapujee Nagar, Danialpet and Thumalapale. In the villages no one cares for them. Their children have abandoned them, and they live in huts without hope. They eat what little they have and sleep. Many of the people in the villages think that these elderly people's lives are over and that they are good for nothing. But God wants these people at their age to know how much he loves them. He wants them to be saved and to enter into his Kingdom.

At the Gospel meetings, we give these elderly people food while they listen to the Good News of Jesus. Many of the them have

not heard about Jesus or the Gospel. Some were born and raised as Hindus. Many of them do not have Bibles, nor do they know how to read or write, but now they are learning. We pray for them, and have seen them healed from chronic pain and illnesses.

Through sharing the Gospel, many elderly people are now accepting Jesus into their lives, and they are so happy to find a new purpose in life. We thank God for GNU's help in helping these people find the joy of the Gospel."

BORN FROM A GNU BLOG

Wilson Mulindwa is the new church pastor at Paradise Hall of Worship in Entebbe, Uganda. A year ago he saw a GNU post on Facebook, and began reading the blogs. His biblical knowledge flourished.

His church is just a new church. Mulindwa and his wife came up with the idea of starting up a church after they saw how most of their friends were genuinely seeking to worship God and were getting exploited by religious leaders who only sought wealth and fame.
